Annual Sports Meet (Theory and Practical over 2 days)

## 2. Objective:

- i) To enhance knowledge of Nutrition, Health Education and Sports.
- ii) To provide a comprehensive understanding of health, fitness, nutrition and sports activity.
- iii) To foster physical/education literacy and promote healthy lifestyle.

#### 3. Context:

GVM's Dr. Dada Vaidya College of Education, Farmagudi, Ponda Goa is the only College in Goa to initiate and continue with the practice of conducting *an Annual Sports Meet* with a combination of theory and practical aspects spread over 2 days. To help students understand the concept of holistic health, its various dimensions and determinants, an array of activities are conducted throughout the entire academic year in addition to the Annual Sports Meet. These activities comprise of intra & extra mural competitions, fitness programs, coaching of sports teams, yoga for promoting healthy lifestyle and talks conducted to foster physical literacy.

#### 4. Practice:

Spearheaded by the College Director of Physical Education Mr. Shaunak Pagi; students are divided into 5 groups for the Annual Sports Meet. On day 1, all groups have to present a topic related to nutrition or health education, and each team gets 30minutes to present the same. These Seminar presentations conducted for developing awareness about lifestyle diseases, psycho-social issues and importance of nutrition, contribute towardsthe development of holistic health of an individual. Day 2 starts with the prayer, oath followed by various sports programs. These programs included activities such as Zumba and March Past followed by competitions like Footcri, Pass Pass Basket, Dodge ball, Obstacle Race and Skipping. All teams had to compete with each other to



win the *Sports Champion Trophy*. The champion team is decided on basis of highest points tallied by the team in the course of the events held on that day.

Department of Physical Education in addition to the *Annual Sports Meet* also conducts intra-mural and extra-mural competitions, excursions, hike/treks, first aid workshops, fitness programmes and various talks by invited guest speakers for the students. Students not only actively participate in all these activities but are also given an opportunity to assist and help organise these activities, thus providing them hands on experience which will benefit them as future teachers.

The overall opportunities provided and experience gained by the students ensures the fact that EDU 10-Health and Physical Education subject certainly helps the students and staff to maintain their health and develop a positive attitude towards life.
