





The following points were discussed:

1. Establishment of Incubation center that will provide training on TET, and in-service training to pass out students on teaching skills. Some amount of budgeting could be kept for expenses to show that there is seriousness in establishing this center.
2. For community work/ College activity for the students following suggestions came:
  - a. Literacy programmes for children of construction workers. Students could be sent on rotations on weekly basis in collaboration with builders.
  - b. Voters' awareness and helping people to get Voters' ID in collaboration with Election Commission of India/Goa.
  - c. Soft skills programmes could be arranged for public including Industrial workers in the form of certificate programmes.
  - d. Training students to write CV.
3. For generation of funds the following suggestions were made.
  - a. Alumni donation in terms of membership
  - b. PTA membership
  - c. Arranging short-term programmes for various groups.
  - d. Getting fund from Industries under Corporate Social Responsibility. Proposals could be sent to their association for this purpose.
4. Few flats could be taken on rent for outstation students. This could be taken from CSR fund if possible.
5. Faculties could be encouraged to take of small research projects and that could be supported financially by the college in the form of seed money. A research committee could be formed to scrutinize research proposals.
6. Alumni could be invited to interact with the students.
7. Faculties could be encouraged to publish in UGC recognized journals and Scopus journals through appropriate incentives. This is being done by private institutions for more quality publications
8. With reference to NAAC, the principal presented prepared AQARs of previous years before the IQAC
9. The meeting ended with vote of thanks by the IQAC coordinator, Mr. Ganesh C Naik.
