Goa Vidyaprasarak Mandal

Goa Vidyaprasarak Mandal, popularly known as GVM was founded by visionaries like Dr. Dada Vaidya, Shri Sitaram Kerkar and Shri Vinayak Sarjyotishi on October 2, 1911 (Vijay Dashami day). The intention of the founders was not merely to impart formal education for white collared jobs but to provide for the future generation, Goans who would be proud of our rich and varied cultural heritage and who would, with confidence, shoulder responsibilities in the task of nation- building.

The first institution to be established was the A. J. de Almeida High School at Ponda. Subsequently in 1960, four high Schools were established viz, R.P.R.S. High School at Bandora, K.R.S.S. High School at Savoi Verem, Pragati Vidyalaya at Borim and M.I.B.K. High School at Khandepar. The S.N.J.A. Higher Secondary School and K.G. and Primary Schools were started in 1975. GVM started two Colleges, the GGPR College of Commerce and Economics and Dr. Dada Vaidya College of Education both at Ponda.

GVM's Adarsh Higher secondary School Ponda was established in 2015.

GVM's Utkarsha Vidyalaya, Ponda was established in 2017.

In all GVM has over 9000 students and 500 teaching and non teaching staff on its roll.

The College of Education

The College of Education started functioning with the first batch of Pre-service B.Ed students in June 1993. The second dimension of the College, In-service Education started with the establishment of the Department of Extension Services in July 1995. The third dimension of distance education through IGNOU B.Ed Study Centre 0806P came into existence in January 2003, with a further addition of MA Education in 2016.

The College has a Research Centre Affiliated to Goa University for Ph.D in the Faculty of Education. The college also runs two year M.Ed programme affiliated to Goa University.

The College has been recognized by various bodies:

- National Council for Teacher Education in December 2000
- NAAC with B+ grade and CGPA of 2.51 on a 4 Point scale.
- Permanent Affiliation to Goa university in June 2002.
- Recognized institution under UGC Act 2F in July 1999 and under 12B in June 2003.

The College has all the infrastructure and instructional facilities required for efficient transaction of the curriculum including:

PRE-PRIMARY TEACHER EDUCATION

The Pre-Primary Teacher Education was launched in October 2005, initially to cater to the pedagogy requirement of in-service teachers at the Pre-school level. From 2017-2018 it was upgraded to pre-service programme - A Diploma in Pre-Primary Teacher Education, affiliated to the Goa University under Community College OA-21.

Introduction

Pre-Primary Education has gained lot of attention in recent years. It has leaped from being a socializing stage for children to a launching pad to the formal school system. All the stakeholders are very keen on its inputs and outputs. It has to become more contemporary and competitive

Pre-Primary/Pre-schol Education:

As the Preschool period covers the age group of 2 to 6 years this is known as Pre gang age, exploratory age, creative age and so on. This witnesses the most rapid development of the child's physical, motor, cognitive, emotional and social skills. Some of the characteristics of preschool children are:

- They are extremely curious about people and things.
- They construct knowledge through interaction with people and the environment.
- There is rapid development of spoken language.
- They are highly receptive and learn new skills rapidly.

Pre-primary/ Pre-school Teacher :

Education of pre-school children is the primary responsibility of the home. However, in recent years this responsibility has been thrust on the schools. As such, the pre-primary teacher has a crucial role in shaping the knowledge and attitude and this programme in pre-primary Teacher Education has been designed to augment the capabilities of teachers in a planned manner.

About the course:

The Course is being conducted since 2005. Sixteen batches of students have been trained. The Course is regularly tuned and refined according to the challenges and felt needs of preschool education. Though the core curriculum remains the same, the inputs are constantly enriched.

The Administration:

The Resource persons:

- Heads of various innovative educational organizations in Goa.

- Experts in different fields like clay modelling, nutrition, computers, Yoga, Theatre, Craft, language development, Puppetry, Origami & Quilling.
- Faculty member of GVM's Dr. Dada Vaidya College of Education as Guest Faculty.

The Programme Design:

The trainees will be given a complete orientation about the course. The Programme will begin with comprehensive discussions about the pre-school child and pre-school education. Trainees will be given training in teaching skills, sent for visits to different pre- schools to spend a day, will give lessons in the school of their choice without supervision, later trainees give supervised lessons. Trainees will visit the observatory, nature trails, teaching aid exhibitions, etc. cooking competitions, using computers and internet, music, puppetry, communication skills and language efficiency are integral part of the Course.

Curriculum Transaction

- Handouts with brief outline.
- Presentation, discussion, reports, etc.
- Practical aspects through field studies/activities, case studies and so on.
- Practical experiences for art, craft, music, drama, rhythmic movements.
- Hands-on experience in other pre-primary schools as per convenience.
- Every unit/subject to have an assignment, test, practical work.
- Every trainee to maintain a portfolio of one's own work.
- Extensive use of technology for transaction of the curriculum.

The Curriculum:

- This curriculum intends to provide inputs in knowledge, attitude and skills.
- Knowledge about pedagogy, technology, teaching techniques, life long learning.
- Attitude to teaching human dignity, good civic sense as well as innovations and professional development.
- Skills to plan, organise Pre-Primary curriculum to prepare teaching aids, to communicate effectively, to develop continuous assessment materials and skills to use technology in teaching.

The major theoretical areas are Child Psychology, Child Development, Teaching Techniques, Evaluation, Safety and First aid, Readiness programme, Health and Nutrition and Environment Studies.

The operational aspects:

The course will be held from June 2021 to April 2022

Schedule : Monday to Friday

Time : 1pm to 6.30 pm.

Time table: Separately made for each month.

Holidays & Vacations: All holidays and vacation as followed by the College.

Course material : The students will be provided with course material developed by the faculty. The list of books that students could refer will be given along with the syllabus. The students will be allowed to borrow library books from the College and the Department of Extension Services.

THE SCHEME OF EVALUATION :

- 1) This evaluation scheme gives more thrust to practicals rather than to theory.
- 2) Practical component could be assessed through observation of students for a specific purpose, identifying, conducting an activity, making of teaching aids, demonstrating, giving lessons in schools.
- 3) Theory component could be assessed through a quiz, objective type test and very short answer type test and restricted response type test.

Evaluation:

Each students will be evaluated continuously through portfolio assessment and supplemented by small written formative and summative tests in the various components such as:

- Communication skills of writing, reading, speaking.
- Planning and execution of classroom Teaching.
- Making and using teaching aids.
- Development of assessment materials
- Theoretical foundations.
- Drama, Music, Acting, Story telling.
- Case study report.

Admission:

Admission procedure: Interview, Written Test.

Criteria for applying:

The minimum qualification is Std.XII Pass. However, preference may be given to those with higher qualification. Since the medium of instruction is English, candidates with fluency in spoken and written English will be preferred. A batch would consist of 40 trainees.

Interview:

Please bring all your academic and co-curricular certificates for the interview. During the interview, the following areas will be considered: Ability to speak English fluently, Confidence, Presentation, Attitude, ability to Sing, Act and Dance.

Written Test :

A short written test will be conducted to assess English Vocabulary, Spelling, Usage of English Grammar and general knowledge. Average grade of interview and Written Test will be considered for admission.

Fees :

The Annual Fees would be Rs. 26,000/- (Rupees Twenty six Thousand Only) which covers the study material, use of computer laboratory, the library, etc.

**The Annual fees could be increased subject to approval from the Goa University and Directorate of Higher Education.*

CERTIFICATION :

On the completion of the Programme, a mark sheet and a certificate would be awarded by the College, certified by Goa University.
