"Environmental Chemistry"

The uniqueness of this event is to energise a multidisciplinary education approach amongst the faculties and students. To make this event successful in instilling curiosity in the minds of students, GVM's Dr. Dada Vaidva College of Education, hosted the Lecture titled, "Environmental Chemistry", delivered by the Resource Person, Dr. Shrikant Ramesh Naik. Dr. Shrikant Ramesh Naik, Assistant Professor, School of Chemical Sciences, Goa University, explained how the environment and Chemistry related to each other in the onset through London Smog, Gulf War, Bhopal Gas tragedy, Chernobyl Nuclear, Minamata disease in Japan, and Agent Orange in Vietnam War. Further points of discussion were the structure of atmosphere, ozone laver- cause and effect of ozone laver depletion. PAN and Los Angeles Smog, acid rain, air quality index, air pollution, Gaseous pollutants, methods of purifying effluent air, eutrophication (water Pollution), green-house effect, causes of floods and how to prevent pollution - at home and school, agricultural sectors.
