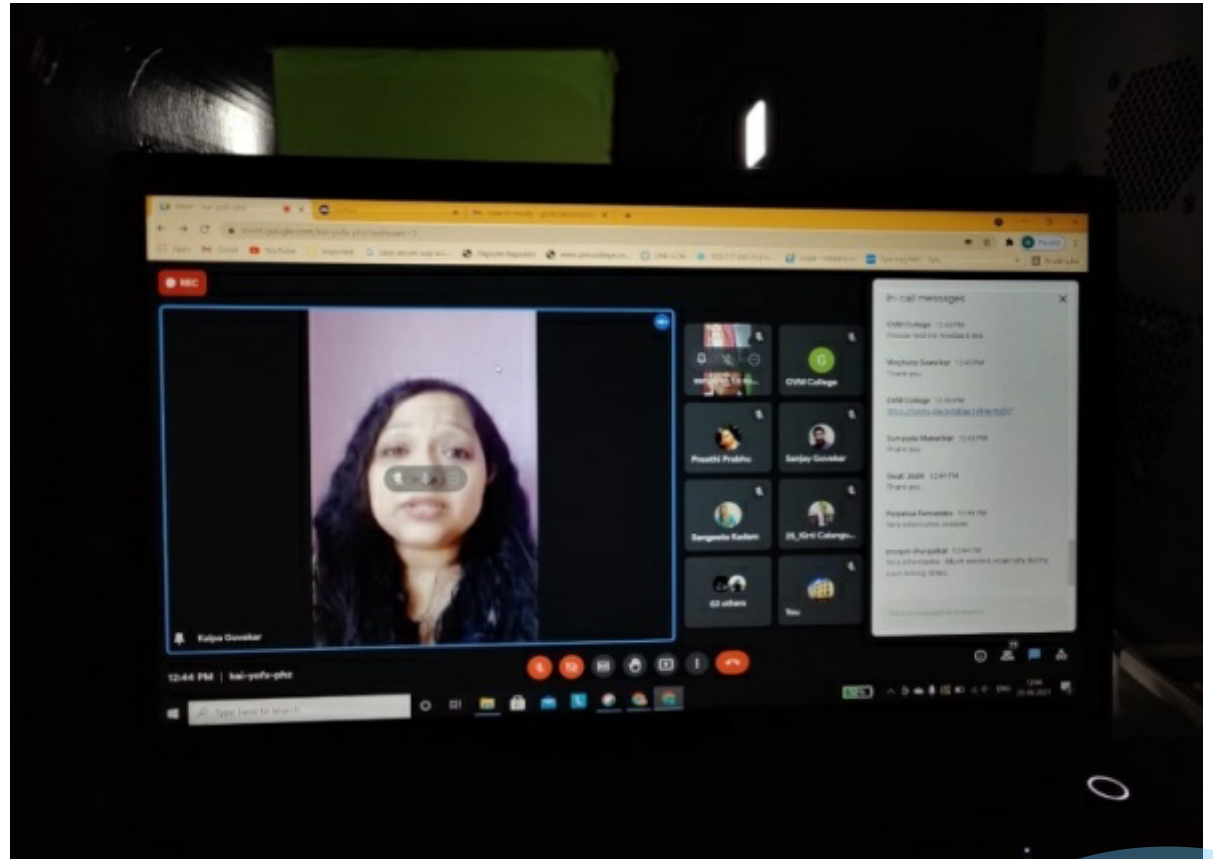
27th July 2021, Tree Plantation

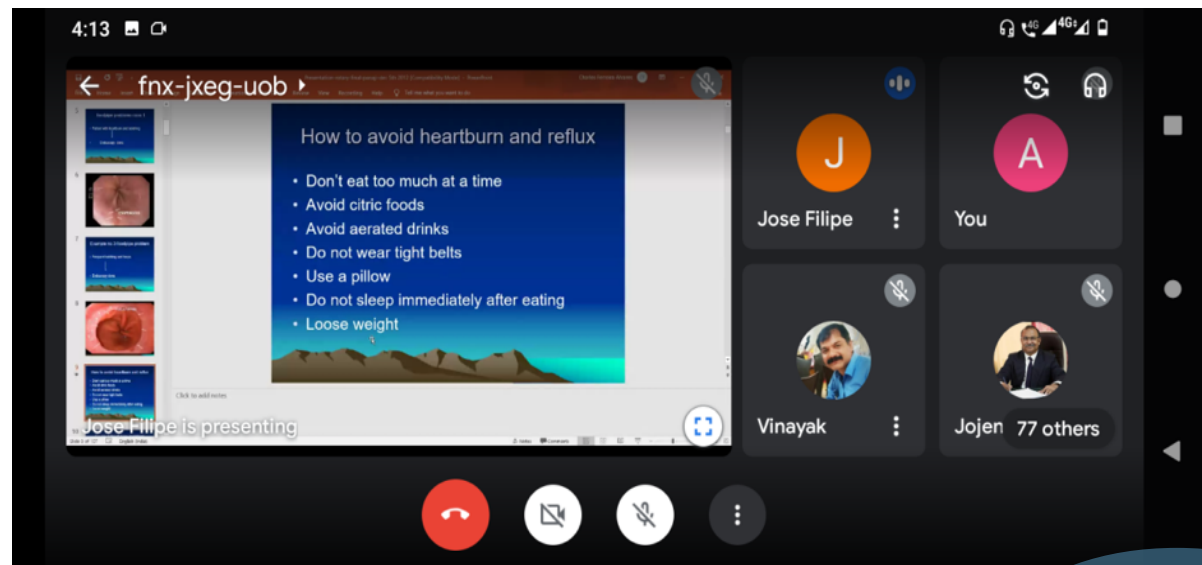
29th July 2021 “Mental Health Talk”

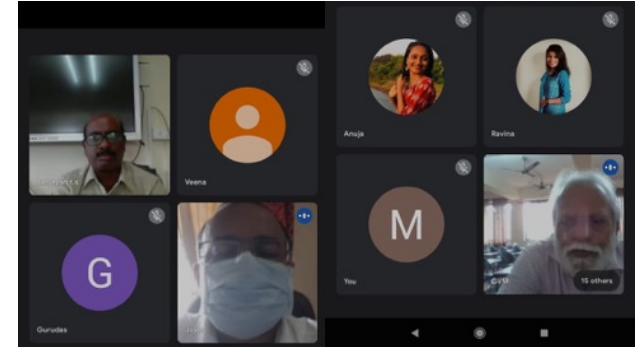
30th July 2021, Gastro Intestinal and Liver Diseases, How to Prevent them?

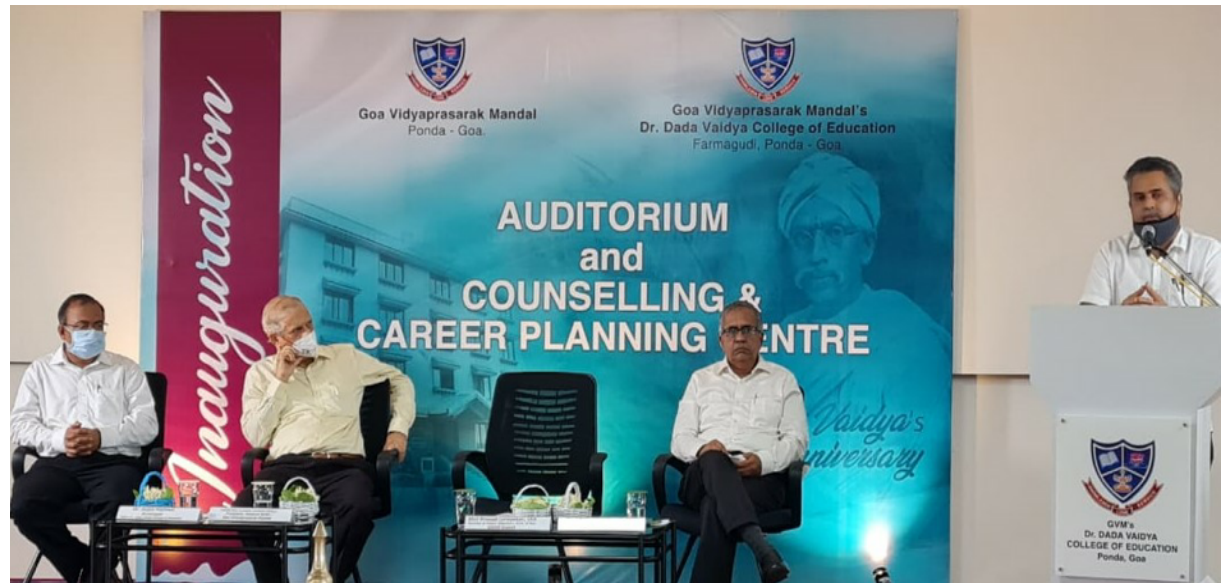
7th September 2021, Ganesh Chaturthi Celebration

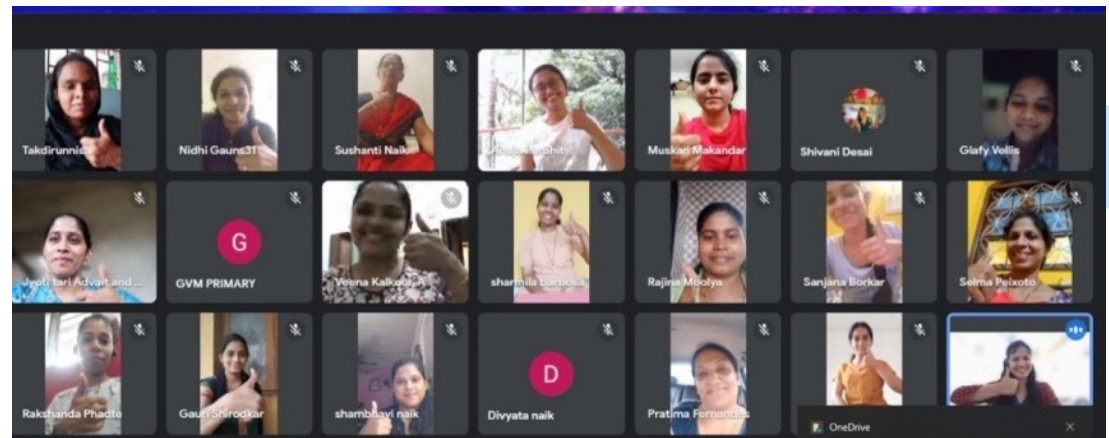
27th September 2021, The Induction program for the first year Masters in Education (2021-2023).
