The following was the discussion in the meeting:

The IQAC coordinator presented the discussion in the previous meeting and briefed the members on the action taken. The college has submitted SSR, DVV process is complete and the NAAC peer team visit date is awaited. The college is now preparing for the NAAC peer team visit.

- 1. The old copper line to be changed to fiber mode for net connection in the college. This is to get an uninterrupted net connection in tune with the latest technology in net connectivity.
- 2. The members agreed to the idea of installing solar lamps in the campus as part of a green initiative. The college can make an effort to get sponsorship for this project.
- 3. The old curtains of windows to be changed as they are old and dirty.

- 8. There was a suggestion to install AC units in the auditorium. As it is located on the top and very large in size, it is better to take an expert opinion and not to hurry with that project.
